BIBLE					4 years suggested.
ENGLISH					3 years required—emphasize writing skills.
MATHEMATICS					2 years required—can be consumer or survival math, pre-algebra, algebra, geometry.
SCIENCE Life science Physical science					2 years required—labs are optional.
SOCIAL SCIENCE World history U.S. history American government/ civics Economics					3 years required—full year courses of U.S. and world history plus 1 semester each of government and economics.
FOREIGN LANGUAGE or FINE ARTS Art, music, drama					1 year of either is required.
PHYSICAL EDUCATION					2 years required.
DRIVER'S EDUCATION					Strongly recommended.
ELECTIVES Typing Computers Auto mechanics Woodshop Electronics Home economics					Seek out future job-interest-related work experience. Investigate apprenticeships.

Use this chart to plan the program for a college bound student. In the columns marked 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th, mark in the years in which you expect to cover that subject. Although not specifically included in the chart, critical thinking skills and personal development are necessary.

SUBJECTS	9TH	10TH	11TH	12TH	COMMENTS
BIBLE					4 years suggested.
ENGLISH					4 years required—emphasize writing skills.
MATHEMATICS Algebra Geometry Advanced Math					Algebra and geometry are generally required. Advanced math is recommended. Taking a course in 12th will keep you in training for college math.
SOCIAL SCIENCES World History U.S. History American Government Economics					3 years are required. Full year courses of U.S. and World History, 1 year combination of governments and economics.
SCIENCE Biology Chemistry Physics Geology, Oceanography, or other					Biology and chemistry usually required. Should include lab work.
FOREIGN LANGUAGE					Some colleges require 2 years of the same language.
DRIVER'S EDUCATION					Recommended for all students.
PHYSICAL EDUCATION					2 years required.
FINE ARTS Art, Music, Drama, Dance					In spite of varying requirements, plan on 1 year of fine arts (California allows the substitution of foreign language for fine arts).
ELECTIVES Typing Computer Home Economics Woodshop					A computer class is highly recommended. Typing skills are almost a necessity.
