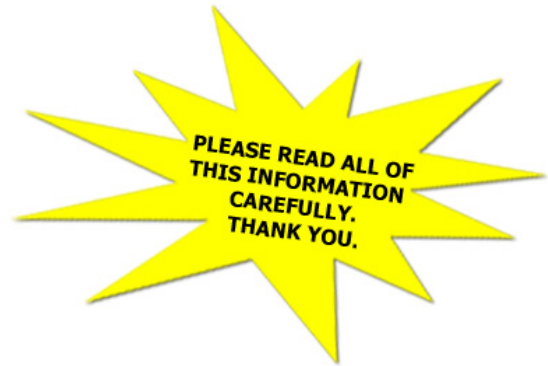




# CHILDREN'S CONFERENCES INTERNATIONAL

**Upon arrival at the convention, please check in at the main convention registration table where you will receive name tags for your children, as well as name tags for the rest of your family. From there, you may proceed to the Children's Program room adjacent to the main Exhibit Hall.**

### IMPORTANT – CHILD DROP-OFF/PICK-UP PROCEDURE

**This process is for the safety of all the children. Please allow yourself time at drop off/pick up to follow these procedures. We cannot make exceptions without the permission of the site's security personnel. Thank you for understanding.**

- **Upon first arrival at the Children's Program door (Exhibit Hall B)**, you will receive a parent name tag sticker. This sticker must be placed on your convention name tag to allow you access into the room to drop off and pick up your child.
- **Before entering the room**, you will be given your child's small group team assignment. You must have your parent sticker affixed to your name tag to enter the children's program area.
- **Walk your child all the way to his or her small group area** and SIGN YOUR CHILD IN with his team leader. Any special instructions should be left in writing with the team leader as well as on the medical release form.
- **The team leader will give you a "My Child Is Signed For" card** to verify that your child is officially signed in. This card will serve as your "exit pass." Please give it to the door greeters as you exit.
- **To pick up your child**, the same parent who dropped off the child must pick up the child OR must have left written authorization with the team leader for another specified person to pick up the child.

Be sure your child is **dressed comfortably** enough to be sitting on the floor AND participating in physical activities and group games.

For your convenience, a concession offering a special children's menu will be open in the rear of the program room to serve **lunch on Friday and Saturday**, and tables will be available for you to eat with your child. You are also welcome to sign your child out for lunch outside the program room.

You won't want to miss the Saturday morning keynote session, when **the children will be highlighted in a short video presentation** showing what they are learning in the program.

During this year's conference, the children will be given the opportunity to donate money for Bibles that will be taken to Peru. CCI will be delivering the Bibles during an upcoming missions trip.
